### ROOM WITH A VIEW



YOU CAN say 'I do' in front of the whole of London now that **Altitude 360** (tel: 0845 500 2929, [squaremeal.co.uk/altitude](http://squaremeal.co.uk/altitude)) has got a wedding licence. Gleaming white floors and black leather seating provide a modern setting for a city wedding and, as the name suggests, there are panoramic views on all sides. The venue, located on the 29th floor of Westminster's Millbank Tower, has a dinner-dance capacity for 300 guests (for a stand-up cocktail reception it can take 600). Its owners also operate The River Room ([squaremeal.co.uk/river-alt](http://squaremeal.co.uk/river-alt)) and Millbank Cinema & Media Centre ([squaremeal.co.uk/millbank-alt](http://squaremeal.co.uk/millbank-alt)), both of which can be incorporated into weddings here. The former is currently awaiting confirmation of its own civil licence, while the latter makes a great setting for speeches with slide shows or film clips.
